BPC have asked a small team to investigate what could be done to remember the 80th Anniversary of D Day on 6th June 2024. Actions that need FC approval at the end

Government guidelines are very "thin" and mainly focus on Beacon Lighting and "Britishness" by using the British tradition of Fish and Chips.

Following much discussion, the following programme was devised (these are planning notes):

- The Beacon would be lit, as per government guidelines at 21:15 we would investigate using a village veteran to perform this action –*Buffs are presenting a Standard bearers and we have a Royal Marine Reserve who was also the ex-headmaster of Borden School to light the Beacon. We also have a Bugle Player, used at the Jubilee, to perform the Last Post and Reveille*
- There is a Proclamation to be read. *The Honourable Robert Hardy has agreed to do this.*
- We would ask Father Jane to give a prayer at the site of the beacon. *The event is in church Diary.*
- Thanksgiving service in the early evening. Father Jane has the event in church Diary.
- A Fish and Chip Van has been booked to be on site throughout the event from 1930 to 2200 *Confirmed by British Fish and Chips, and all booked from 1930 through to 2200. Location on the Playstool by Memorial Gardens. Power socket required to run fridges, Dan to provide,. 1930 to 2000 to prepare frying time.*
- Dan to provide background 40's music and a PA *Confirmed he is available on the* 6th June *and booked.*
- The Maypole Minstrels have been asked to perform for 30 minutes with period songs *Confirmed they will attend*.
- A welcome and why tonight would be given by Clive. *Clive with Father Jane to arrange for Junior members of the community to read extracts from Solders Experiences.*
- The event would be registered with SWALE through TENS -Brian / Clerk done and approved
- Banner in the church entrance advertising the event facing the triangle. *Given to Church Warden for putting up in the Church Yard*
- Advertise in the Broadside Advertised in the last 2 additions of Broadside
- Beacon Fuel Arranged Clive and Brian to collect the week of the event
- Notify Maypole *Done*
- Safety tape *We have tape from Coronation*.
- National Ring out the Bells Borden Belltower Captain Informed and agreed.
- Flyer for School the week before the event *Brian to arrange*.
- Advertise on Village Websites Brian to Arrange.
- Ask Dan to provide music from 20:00 to 20:30 Agreed
- Double Mic at History one to be held in front of children while they read the other for Clive. Agreed
- Commerative souvenirs for the Children helping with the presentation on the evening.-Waiting FC approval


